MCC has completed 24 compacts. Two other compacts (Madagascar and Mali) were terminated after military coups.

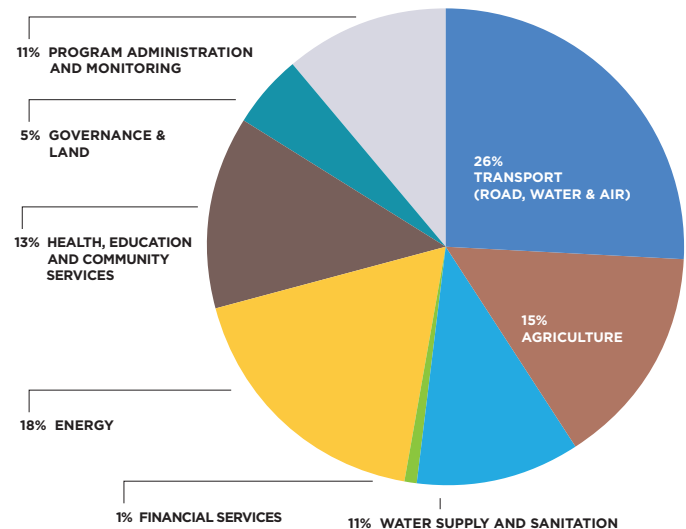
